


ANCIENT GREECE



Design your own pot. You could draw (or make) your own Ancient Greek pot using traditional patterns and scenes. You might choose to include story on the pot from one of the myths we will be learning about.

Produce a brochure to persuade people to visit Greece. Consider how you would like to lay this out, using images to catch the reader's attention. Your content could include references to: the history of Greece, the geography of Greece (a map), the weather, any famous landmarks and more!

Build a model of a Greek Temple (e.g. the Parthenon). You could use a range of different materials such as: cardboard, paper, Lego or recycled materials.

Research a famous Greek and present your findings in any way you wish – this could be using PowerPoint, written notes, pictures, a poster or a speech. You could even present this to someone at home!

Greek Alphabet Challenge - learn the Greek alphabet and write your name or a short message using Greek letters.

Make an **Ancient Greek Menu** - create a menu for a feast in Ancient Greece. Include: Starters, main dishes, desserts and drinks - all based on historical Greek food. You could decorate it like an ancient scroll or menu card.
