

SURVIVOR TOPIC HOME LEARNING TASKS

DT (Design & Technology): Build a Snow Vehicle

- Task: Design a vehicle that could travel across ice and snow.
- Activity: Build a model using LEGO, recycled materials, or cardboard.
- Extension: Label the parts and explain how it helps in Antarctica's environment.

History: Antarctic Exploration Timeline

- Task: Research key events in Antarctic exploration (e.g., Amundsen, Scott, Shackleton).
- Activity: Create a timeline with dates, explorers' names, and key events.
- Extension: Add modern events like the Antarctic Treaty or climate research breakthroughs.

Music: Antarctic Soundscape

- Task: Imagine the sounds you might hear in Antarctica (wind, ice cracking, animal calls).
- Activity: Create a soundscape using instruments or household objects to recreate these sounds.
- Extension: Compose a short piece of music inspired by Antarctica.

PE: Polar Expedition Challenge

- Task: Pretend you're an explorer trekking across Antarctica.
- Activity: Set up an indoor/outdoor obstacle course (e.g., crawling, jumping over "icebergs," balancing).
- Extension: Time your expedition and try to beat your record!

English: Antarctic Creature Poem

- Task: Choose an Antarctic animal (like an orca or penguin).
- Activity: Write a poem describing the animal and its icy home – use similes, metaphors, or personification.
- Extension: Turn it into a performance poem or animate it with simple drawings.

Maths: Antarctic Supply Planning

- Task: Imagine you're planning an expedition.
- Activity: Create a shopping list for a month in Antarctica. Budget your food, fuel, clothes, and tools.
- Extension: Calculate the weight of the supplies and how they would be transported.

French Language: Antarctica Words

- Task: Learn how to say 10 Antarctic-related words (e.g., ice, penguin, cold, snow) in French
- Activity: Make a vocabulary poster with translations and pictures.
- Extension: Write a few simple sentences using your new words.
