



# Maths Open Week at BPS!



The week beginning **Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May** is Maths Open Week at Bewdley Primary School! We are excited to again invite parents and carers to come and visit their child's Maths lesson.

## **What happens in an open maths lesson?**

The idea is that you sit alongside your child and experience a 'normal' maths lesson. This will give you a chance to see how we teach Maths at BPS.

## **How do I let my child's teacher know when I'll be coming into school?**

Decide which day is best for you to visit and then complete the form using the link for your child's class below no later than **Friday 15<sup>th</sup> May**. Please complete a form for **EACH** child you have in school. This will give the teachers an idea of how many parents to expect on the day. *Please note that Year 1 are visiting Think Tank on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May and Year 3 will be at Worcester Cathedral on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> May.*

## **I've decided which day I can attend; what time do I come along?**

Maths lessons will start across the school at 8.45am for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, and 8:55am for Years 3-6 this week. Once you have dropped your child off at their classroom door, please walk round to the school office to sign in. You will then wait in the school hall until either an adult shows you to your child's class or, if your child is in Years 3-6, they come to claim you!

The lessons will last for approximately 45 minutes, although Reception's lesson will be shorter. At the end of the lesson, you will be shown back to the school entrance. We know there are a few children who may be sad to see their parents go. If this does happen, please could we ask that you say a quick goodbye and leave. Their teachers and TAs will look after them and it'll be soon be forgotten as they head out for play!

## **What do I do if I have more than one child in school?**

You can either spend one lesson with one child and then come in on another day for your other child or, if you are only able to come to one open lesson, you can split your time between your children's classes.

## **I hated Maths at school, do I *have* to come?**

Yes! Please don't let how you feel about Maths put you off! Your child will love sharing their learning with you – you don't have to actually do any Maths, just see what happens in the class. There is great enthusiasm for Maths across the school – you may even catch the Maths bug!
