



Spending Money

Although there are several places to buy food at Legoland, we always ask the children to bring a disposable lunch with them. This avoids the expensive food prices and the very long food queues. The only queues we want to be in are for the exciting rides and having packed lunches means we can eat on the go, whilst we wait!



The main Legoland shop is mainly cashless but does have a 'Cash Only' till, so children will be able to buy things from the main store either with cash or card. Please see below for a guide to the prices of items in the shop. We recommend that children buy smaller souvenirs, rather than big LEGO sets. We would advise around £20 spending money at the most. Children will be looking after their own money and/or cash cards on the day.

Phones



Please do not send phones with the children. We'll update you with travel arrangements using the school's text system. We will take lots of photos to share afterwards, so children won't need to take their own and can concentrate on just having fun!

Travel Sickness

If your child gets travel sick, please give them a travel sickness tablet before they come to school at 7.15am. You will need to complete a medication form and give Mrs Woodward the tablet in the original packaging for the return journey at drop off.

Contacting the Year 6 Team

If you need to contact the Year 6 team during the school day, please get in touch with the school office who will forward any messages to us. If you need to get a message to us after 4pm, please email Mrs Woodward and Mrs Brazier, who will check their messages regularly. Please do not email about arrival times, though—we'll text everyone together.

Food and Drink

The children need a packed lunch and water bottle.

Children are welcome to take snacks and other drinks for the day too. This will be much more economical than buying them there!



We'll be having a stop-off at Oxford Services on the way home for children to eat their packed meal from home. Although we'll have time to use the toilets, children won't be able to buy food and drink at the services. Their packed evening meal can remain on the coach during the day, if it's in a separate bag.
