In response to the MET office red weather warnings close to our region tomorrow (24/6/26) and Thursday (25/6/26) of this week, we will be modifying our school day.

The forecast for high 30 degrees and possibly 40 degrees, peaking in the afternoon, poses a significant health and safety risk for our students and staff.

Our school day will therefore finish at 1pm tomorrow and Thursday, in line with The Bewdley School and St. Anne's Primary School.

Please collect your children from their classrooms as normal. The gate will be open from 12:55.

Lunches will still be served before this. If you wish to change your child's hot lunch option, please change this on School Grid as soon as possible.

All children are welcome to wear their **school PE kits**. This does not include any variations of strappy tops, crop tops or football kits.

We appreciate that this early finish for the next two days may create some challenges for families but the safety of our children and staff is our priority.

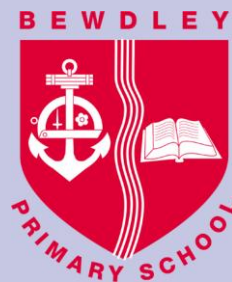
