Dear Parents and Carers,

With the changing forecasts this week, it has been tricky to plan how we are going to modify this week's activities for the best. However, based on the current forecasts, please find below the changes that we have decided to go ahead with.



Wednesday - Shrek

Children in Years 2-5 were due to walk to West Midlands Safari Park to watch the Year 6 dress Rehearsal of Shrek. As this is a two hour long round trip, plus a stop for lunch, in largely unshaded areas, we have decided not to go ahead with this activity.

Children in school will still be able to watch the performance as we are going to live stream it from the Safari Park into the classrooms.

Lunches will remain the same and children will picnic in school/in shaded areas outside.

Due to England's fixture in the evening, the later production will now start at 5:30pm. If you are a Year 6 parent and you now need an extra ticket for a sibling, please contact the school office.

Thursday – Sports Day

Sports Day will be going ahead, however, there will be certain adaptations.

Parents can choose whether their child will take part in Sports Day or, alternatively, they can stay inside with a staff member completing a non-curriculum based activity. The Sports Day activities will be amended and adapted depending on the time of day and the temperature at the time. The traditional races at the end of the day may not take place – this will be risk assessed on the day.



Parents must make this choice before 9am on Thursday morning to allow staff to organise the events. If you wish to remove your child from Sports Day, you can tell you child's class teacher on the door or email them to say this. If you want them to take part in Sports Day, you do not need to contact the school.

The shared lunch will continue as planned. We encourage parents and carers to bring chairs and blankets with them, which will allow us to utilise the shade that is available. The playtime section at lunchtime will be reduced.

All children will need a hat and a refillable water bottle. Drinks will also be available to purchase.

Reception and Key Stage One will start at 10:00

Shared lunch is from 12:00 – 12:45 (this time may be reduced)

Key Stage Two will start at 1:00

If Sports Day for Key Stage Two finishes early, parents will be able to take children home with them. However, any children who are walking home without an adult won't be released from classes until 3:10 as normal.
